

**Punj Lloyd gets solar contract**

Engineering and construction major Punj Lloyd today said in New Delhi it had won the country's largest solar-based contract worth Rs 232 crore for installing water treatment plants in Bihar from the state government. The EPC (engineering, procurement and construction) contract for 850 solar-powered water treatment plants for removal of arsenic and fluoride across multiple districts in Bihar will be implemented on a turnkey basis, a company statement said. "The combined solar power generation of these plants will be greater than 1.3 MW. With the government's commitment to the National Solar Mission, this project provides the foundation to establish Punj Lloyd as a leading solar company in this space," it said. — PTI
